Its often the case that the earlier we pick up the disease the more we can do. However sometimes symptoms don't become apparent until the damage has been done, that's why we've put together a comprehensive check list to uncover signs before they become a problem.

What can I expect from the After 8 club?

FREE Health Assessment check and advice

FREE Head to tail physical examination

FREE Urine test

FREE blood pressure measurement—cats

FREE 6 monthly check ups (equivalent to you visiting your GP every 3-4 years)

A mini blood screen for £9.99, a saving of 70% (optional).



The nurse will start by carrying out a full health check on your pet. She can then give you advice on diet, exercise and body condition, dental care, joint stiffness and general care. The FREE urine test is a simple way of detecting kidney problems however it will not tell us the extent of the damage. The discounted blood sample will detect how much damage there is to the kidneys but also gives us valuable information about other body systems such as the liver, glucose levels and protein levels. You may feel these tests are unnecessary as your pet appears to be well, but your pet could lose up to 75% of their kidney function before showing any signs. By this time the treatment could be too little too late.

What will I get out of the After 8 club?

The checks will help you be more aware of your pets health and we can give you the help and support you may need to manage any conditions that we detect.

What's the catch?

There is no catch. We often find that a lot of owners don't bring their pets to us because they think they are just getting old. When they do come in they are often surprised at how much we can do for their pet and how positively they respond to the treatment.
